



Fee concession is available to all SC/ST students irrespective of considering their annual family income.

#### Criteria for fee waivers /scholarships

For applying for educational fee concession, Annual family income should be less than one Lakh.

In addition to the sanctioned intake in Polytechnic Colleges, 5% of seats in each programme in every Polytechnic College are provided under the Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme for Women, economically backward\* and Physically Challenged\*\* meritorious students. The 5% seats provided additional to the sanctioned intake in each programme shall be filled in the ratio 1:1:1 for Women, Economically Backward (Annual family income up to Rs. 6,00,000) and Physically Challenged students based on merit.
